


# Commonwork Bore Place field trail



15 16 17 18

From Batfold Wood, enter the field and keep to the right hand field edge until you reach an open area with large, free-standing oak trees. At this point you can turn left, down to a stile and follow a path through a narrow woodland shaw to the road and Bough Beech Reservoir. At the road turn right and follow the road until you reach Kent Wildlife Trust's visitor centre on the left (01622 662012 for opening times).

Or you can turn right at the large oak trees and enter Red Robin. Keep to the left hand field edge until you reach a stile on the left. Go over the stile into Shooting Box and walk across the field towards the northeast corner. Cross over the stile and follow the path down to the old Oast on the left. This is the end of the field trail.

From the vegetable plot, walk across the field to the top corner by the wood. Through the gate follow the path through the woodland shaw to another gate. Turn right and follow the edge of the field.

You can make a detour to Mount Field Pond, which is hidden by trees.

5 6 7 8

Keep to the field edges where shown on the map. Follow the narrow woodland shaw through the fields to Donald's Pond.

13 14 15

From Kilnhouse Wood, walk across Kiln Field towards the Plantation. At the Plantation take a sharp left through Batfolds to Batfold Wood. Aim for the corner of the woods, pass the corner and find the stile. From 13 to 14 you should walk steadily and continually uphill. Follow the path through Batfold Wood to the stile at 15.

12 13

Follow the path past two ponds and up some steps. The path will lead onto Kilnhouse Ride, which is a wide path through the woods. Turn right onto the ride and follow the path out of the woods over a stile.

7  
Make a detour to Donald's Pond and rest in the shade of a newly created willow shelter. Watch for wildlife visiting the pond. **Take care, the water is deep.**

8 9

Go through the gate onto the road. Turn left and then first right opposite two cottages on a bend. Take the first opening on the right, which leads through Bushy Wood.

10 11

At the end of the woods turn right and follow the edge of the field to the stile. Go over the stile into a woodland shaw and follow the path over two bridges and into Riddens Field over a stile.

11 12

Follow the left hand edge of the field and then turn sharp right and cross the field to the stile leading onto the road. Cross over the road and go up a few steps into Kilnhouse Wood. If you prefer you can follow the road back to the car park at Bore Place.
