- estate management including woodland (24 ha), private tenancy agreements both tenant and landlord, renewable energy installations and estate properties

- excellent husbandry, herd, farm and budget management skills
- proven ability to lead and inspire a small team whilst working directly as part of the team on a day to day basis

- proactive and up to date approach to H&S legislation
- experience or an interest in organic farming systems and a commitment to conservation, sustainability and organic principles
- up-to-date working knowledge of countryside stewardship schemes (desirable)
- wider estate management experience (desirable)
