10:00	Welcome and safety briefing. Introductory discussion. What is regenerative farming?

11:30	Guided walk to explore farmland habitats, eg woodlands, meadows and ponds. Practical conservation or surveying task, for example reptile or dormouse surveying.
12:30	Lunch

Important information about your visit

- Please ensure students bring a packed lunch
- Please ensure students wear suitable clothing: this should be clothes that can get a bit dirty and that are appropriate for the season of your visit. At all times of the year, optimum clothing includes waterproofs and wellies.
- **It is essential that all students and accompanying adults bring two pairs of footwear: a pair suitable for the tour of the farm (ideally wellies) and a pair for indoor/travel use.**
