## SPACES

There are several licensed rooms and outdoor spaces at Bore Place where you can hold your ceremony, and all can be set up exactly how you like.

All our spaces are adaptable. Most can be used for ceremonies as well as the celebrations.

#### The Hide in Bore Place Garden

The Hide is a magical, idyllic setting for your ceremony, seating up to 100 guests.

### The Large Barn

A restored 17th century timber building, the Large Barn is a flexible space and makes a perfect venue for a traditional or vintage style ceremony, seating up to 100 guests.

### The Drawing Room

A large, traditionally furnished drawing room with a stunning open fireplace overlooking pretty organic borders and beds informally planted around a laid lawn, seating up to 70 guests.

#### The Studio

A bright, contemporary panelled room, seating up to 50 guests and with direct access to the enchanting terrace overlooking the walled garden and ornamental pond.









## FOOD & DRINK

We work with a number of carefully selected partners who you can choose from to provide your food and bar. Our catering partners have been carefully chosen for their high standards, flexibility and shared values. They can meet all budgets and tastes.


They are also very experienced at catering for vegan and vegetarian weddings.

## VENUE HIRE INFORMATION




